K-STEP Begins Kansas Library Transgender Education Series.

Kansas Statewide Transgender Education Project (K-STEP) will begin its Kansas Library Transgender Education Series, August 21<sup>st</sup> at the Johnson County Central Resources Library, 9875 W. 87th St. in Overland Park. The program will be from 2pm to 4pm. It is free and open to the public.

Stephanie Mott, K-STEP Executive Director, says, “We hope to make transgender education available for all Kansans, and this is another step toward making that happen. Additionally, there are transgender Kansans everywhere in the state, many of whom are not aware of the resources we can provide.”

Following the Johnson County Library event, trainings are currently scheduled for September 11<sup>th</sup> in Pittsburg, September 17<sup>th</sup> in Hays, and September 24<sup>th</sup> in Emporia. Each of the trainings is scheduled in the local library from 2-4 pm.

The content of the educational programs will include personal journeys of transgender individuals, discussion of transgender terminology, interactive learning, and a question & answer session.

Mott shared, “Our plan is to continue to schedule as many as ten more events at different locations throughout Kansas before the end of the year. One of the things that was clearly apparent from our Fourth of July Weekend Trans-Tour across the state, is that there is a great need for this type of education.”
